
PAYMENT

- Payment/copay is due at time of service.
- There will be a fee for your visit. Other services, including lab tests, will be billed in addition.
- Medicare patients of the HRRMC Outpatient
 Pavilion in Salida will receive one explanation
 of benefits—clinic charges will be added to any
 hospital charges that may be incurred on that
 same day. Medicare patients are charged the
 same amount as non-Medicare patients, but
 the bill is broken down differently for Medicare
 reimbursement.
- A 15% prompt-payment discount is available to self-pay and uninsured patients.
- We accept cash, check, Visa, Mastercard and Discover.
- Claims with most insurance plans are filed on your behalf.
- Structured payment plans are available.


HRRMC internists see patients at the HRRMC Outpatient Pavilion on the hospital campus in Salida.
